# RHPP Detailed monitoring programme



#### 400 heat pumps

For heat pumps, monitor SPF2 and SPF4:

$$SPF2 = \frac{Q_{HP}}{E_{HP}}$$

$$SPF4 = \frac{(Q_{HP} + E_{Immersion})}{(E_{HP} + E_{Auxiliary} + E_{Immersion} + E_{Circulation\_pumps})}$$

### Social Housing RHI Programme



DECC is funding monitoring and evaluation of a number of renewable heat projects in the social housing sector

- Biomass boilers
- Ground source heat pumps
- Air source heat pumps
- Solar thermal panels

Encourage off gas grid

All to be insulated, (if not already insulated)

All technologies to be installed by MCS accredited installers.



### Social Housing RHI Programme (2)



Projects selected on the basis of a number of criteria, including:

- Quality of monitoring proposed
- Quality of proposed surveys of the householders
- Support to householders
- Innovation
- Value for money

The funding agreed is £3m from DECC.


